



Beasley Allen to host *Seat Check Saturday*

August 27, 2015: On September 19, Beasley Allen will host the sixth Seat Check Saturday in the River Region. The Seat Check Saturday event is part of National Child Passenger Safety Week, an annual event presented by the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration (NHTSA). Certified technicians will be on site to inspect, install and instruct caregivers on the importance of child safety seats. The campaign is just a part of the larger focus of Beasley Allen Law Firm, which strives to help “those who need it most.”

Beginning in May of this year, Beasley Allen has taken part in three tire safety checks in the area. Many people do not realize that tires, regardless of wear or appearance, have a suggested life of six years. Beasley Allen has partnered with the Prattville and Millbrook Police Departments to educate vehicle owners and drivers about the Department of Transportation (DOT) code that can be found on all tires. The DOT code indicates the week and month a tire was manufactured, which in turn tells us when it should be discarded. It is recommended that tires be replaced after six years, regardless of use or wear.
